


Quick Start Guide: New Merged Excel File

Simple file (merged and separate tabs):



The "Simple Merged" file just has the basics. Some instructors may choose to use this worksheet for importing scores into Blackboard Grade Center.

Note: If you only had one version of the exam, this will just be called (Simple).



Next to the Simple Merged tab are tabs for each version of the exam you gave.



The RAW file was previously known to some as a "DLM" write in only request. Spring semester 2014, we gave the RAW file when there was a request for 'Weighting, Subtests and Extra Credit' and also offered it as a stand-alone 'Advanced Option.' This, however, caused confusion to instructors who had been used to always checking off the type of data file (separate or merged) they needed on the old request forms. Now, we are including the Raw file with every exam for those who wish to use the extra fields of information.



Note: If you only had one version of the exam, this will just be called (Raw).



Next to the Raw Merged tab are tabs for each version of the exam you gave.



The separate versions of the Raw file will have the fields for birthday and gender. Those are seldom used fields so they have not been included in the Raw Merged tab but are still available for those instructors who wish to utilize them.
